Coach of UCLA Bruins -1949-1975 (retired)  
Coach of Indiana State University - 1947-1948

## **Career Records:**

**Most consecutive NCAA victories:** 88. Wooden is the only basketball coach to have four consecutive undefeated seasons, all at UCLA  
**Most NCAA championships:** 10, all with UCLA  
**Most consecutive NCAA championships:** 7  
**Most undefeated PAC-8 conference championships:** 8. No other PAC-8 (now the PAC-10) team has ever gone undefeated in conference play  
Has been involved in the McDonald's All American Game since its inception in 1978

## **Professional Awards:**

One of only two men (Lenny Wilkens) to be inducted into the National Basketball Hall of Fame as both a player (1960) and coach (1970)  
College Basketball Player of the Year - 1932 at Purdue University  
Three-time All-American at Purdue  
Awarded Big Ten Medal for Proficiency in Scholarship and Athletics - Purdue, 1932  
Elected to Helms Athletic All-Time All American Basketball Team in 1943  
Inducted into the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame in 1964  
College Coach of the Year - 1964, 1967, 1969, 1970, 1972, 1973  
*Sporting News* Sportsman of the Year in 1970  
*Sports Illustrated* Man of the Year in 1973
